An Ecumenical movement of prayer for peace and reconciliation which began in 1956 during a goodwill visit to East Asian countries by an international team of women, sponsored by women of the Uniting Presbyterian Church in the United States of America.

A Fellowship of Prayer, without any discrimination of race, colour, culture or denomination, enabling all, whether rich or poor, educated or illiterate, in urban or rural areas, to participate in the offering of their 'least coin', thus enabling '*gifts of love*' to be provided for projects all over the world. Australia is one of 80 countries linked together in this unique movement.

Fellowship of the Least Coin contributions from individuals and groups are sent through State Units, and details of the Grants made each year are listed in the Asian Church Women's Quarterly Bulletin.

**The Circle of Prayer Booklet** of meditations and prayers for use in the presentation of the FLC offering, is prepared by women of different countries and is available from State Units of ACW.

## THE WINIFRED KIEK SCHOLARSHIP

is named for the Rev Winifred Kiek, MA, BD, who was a pioneer in co-ordinating the work of church women, and a Life Member of Australian Church Women, 1884-1975. The purpose of the Scholarship is to provide supplementary training for a Christian woman of multicultural Australia, Pacific Island nations and/or member countries of Asian Church Women's Conference in rotation. When it is appropriate the Awards may support designated education and charitable projects for Women through programmes of the National Council of Christian World Service.

It is hoped that Scholarship recipients will later give leadership in Church and Community in their own countries.

Available annually for one academic year, the Winifred Kiek Scholarship covers fares, tuition fees, and accommodation costs, and is also available for shorter periods.

**FELLOWSHIP DAY SERVICES** provide the opportunity to give towards this fund. They are held each year, in July.
